My great Grandfather Emigrated to Canada in 1889. His brother Frederick emigrated to the United States, Detroit area. I have no info/contact with those relatives except what I have learned from this great web site. Per notice of death in the Winnipeg Tribune Newspaper: "Albert George Cowley, 77 of 841 William Avenue Winnipeg one of the first presidents of the Winnipeg Trades and Labour Council died Tuesday in St. Boniface Hospital. He had been a resident of Winnipeg for 53 years. Mr. Cowley was born at Brighton England. He was connected with the city stores department as an employee for 19 years (fired during the Winnipeg General Strike 1919) and later became employed with the Blue Ribbon Stores, where he remained working until his retirement about 12 years ago. He was president of the Trades and Labour Council in 1902-03 and again for six months in 1919, and had attended conventions throughout the country as a delegate for many years."
