### General:

Caroline Ellen was married to William Henry Marshall. (See Carrie Marshall's baptism record.) Carrie and Ellen were definitely children of this marriage. From the date of the marriage I believe that Lionel and Cecil were also children of this marriage.

William Henry died in 1899. Caroline Ellen then re-married to John Elford Gulley in about 1901.

The address given in the 1891 census was 1, Holt Street Buildings, Wrexham. From historical accounts of Wrexham at the turn of the 19th century, this was one in a terrace of properties lying somewhere between the current indoor market and the roundabout by the swimming baths. It seems to have been a fairly 'seedy' area of the town with open sewers. The properties were demolished in the late 1930s as part of Wrexham's slum clearance programme.
